The present execution petition has been filed for execution of the judgment under Order XII Rule 6 CPC, and the decree dated 15.11.2025 passed by the Ld. Predecessor of this Court. The Judgment Debtor had duly appeared and contested the suit during the trial.

The execution petition was taken up on 06.01.2026. Notice of the present execution petition was accepted by the learned counsel for the Judgment Debtor on 12.01.2026. Thereafter, at the request of the learned counsel for the Judgment Debtor, the matter was adjourned on several occasions to enable the Judgment Debtor to file his reply/objections to the present execution petition. Despite repeated opportunities, including the imposition of costs, the Judgment Debtor has failed to file any reply/objections to the execution petition. The costs imposed have also not been paid till date. It is apparent that the Judgment Debtor has failed to avail the opportunities granted by this Court and has delayed the execution proceedings without any sufficient cause. There are no merits in the submissions made by the Ld. Counsel for the JD regarding maintainability of the present petition.

Accordingly, Issue Warrants of Attachment of movable articles of Judgment Debtor on filing of PF and list of movable articles for next date of hearing. Steps be taken within one week w.e.f. today.

Decree Holder to appear before the Ld. Administrative Civil Judge, South District, Saket Courts, New Delhi for appointment of Bailiff on **20.07.2026**.
